Summary report prepared by Dr. Alistair Bath on behalf of the workshop participants.

Introduction: On Wednesday, December 18th, 2019, the Carrbridge Capercaillie Group gathered for the final workshop facilitated by Dr. Alistair Bath to conclude the group's work with Dr. Bath and identify next steps.

Format of the workshop day: The workshop focused on reviewing in detail the full results from the quantitative research conducted by Dr. Bath to ensure, through a facilitated session, that the group had not overlooked any key points in the data and in so doing not reflected the common ground in the community through the activities in the Carrbridge Capercaillie Conservation Strategy. The group welcomed the opportunity to reflect in detail on the research and considered the need for more time to develop and refine the Carrbridge Capercaillie Conservation Strategy in the new year to ensure it thoroughly reflects the opportunities and issues at play within the community.

Next steps: The group agreed to meet in the new year to pick up the draft strategy as it stands and to move it forward ready for publication in the coming months.
