

Carrbridge Capercaillie Group
Meeting notes: 26 May 2020

1. The group discussed the consultation on the Carrbridge Capercaillie Conservation Strategy and agreed to publish the strategy and start the consultation on 8 June.
2. The group discussed and agreed the process for the consultation including how to replicate the previously planned drop-in session in the Village Hall. It was agreed, in accordance with public health guidelines, that three virtual Q&A sessions would be held and hosted on the project website instead.
3. It was agreed that the strategy would be posted to all households via Royal Mail with a form for residents to share their views. Cover letters from the group and the CNPA and a copy of the June edition of Carrbridge Capercaillie News would also be included with the strategy.
4. It was agreed that residents would also be able to share their views via the project website; the Bath & Associates research report would be available on the project website from 8 June; and a joint press release about the consultation would be sent to the Strathly by the CNPA.
