

## **Carrbridge Capercaillie Group**

### **Meeting notes: 9 July 2020**

1. The group agreed that the Carrbridge News Facebook page could be used to remind residents about the consultation on the Carrbridge Capercaillie Conservation Strategy. The closing date for the consultation is Friday 31 July.
2. The group agreed not to publish a July edition of the Carrbridge Capercaillie newsletter. Instead, an August edition will be published with the consultation results. It will also include an outline of the next steps for the Carrbridge Capercaillie Conservation Strategy and the funding available for developing and delivering the strategy.
3. The group agreed to review Tom's work (the Community Ranger) in August, once the consultation on the strategy is complete and all the views shared have been reviewed. Currently Tom is working alongside the other Rangers employed by the CNPA to provide a welcome at key visitor 'hotspots' as the lockdown eases and visitors return to the Park. Tom is undertaking this work in and around Carrbridge, including in capercaillie sensitive areas.
