

**Carrbridge Capercaillie Group**  
**Meeting notes: 30 July 2020**

1. It was agreed that all the feedback received through the consultation on the Carrbridge Capercaillie Conservation Strategy will be published on the project website ([cairngormscapercaillie.scot](http://cairngormscapercaillie.scot)) on 10 August.
2. It was agreed that a summary of the consultation results will also be included in the August edition of Carrbridge Capercaillie News.
3. The group discussed the next steps for the strategy and agreed to meet again in August to review, in detail, the feedback received through the consultation; ways to integrate the feedback into the strategy; and begin to prioritise the Key Actions within the strategy for further development over the short, medium and long-term.
4. The group agreed to review Tom, the Community Ranger's work programme when they meet again in August. Tom is still working alongside the other Rangers employed by the CNPA to provide a welcome at key visitor 'hotspots' as the lockdown eases and visitors return to the Park. Tom is continuing to undertake this work in and around Carrbridge.
5. The group agreed to re-visit the idea of creating a Community Ranger 'base' in the village for Tom to use.
