

Carrbridge Capercaillie Group meeting notes Sunday 21 August

Action Plan: 2022 - 2023

The Action Plan for 2022 - 2023 was approved by the Project Board on 23 June. The Cairngorms Capercaillie Project Team have since been supporting the Carrbridge Capercaillie Group to deliver the Action Plan. The group met with members of the Project Team to review the progress made against all actions and the following next steps were agreed:

1. Once it's available, Elspeth to share the first proof of the updated Community Paths leaflet with the group for comment.
2. Elspeth to source 3 quotes for an all-weather Carrbridge Nature noticeboard, including quotes from suppliers / contractors in the village.
3. Elspeth to liaise with Carrbridge Primary School about using the noticeboard.
4. Elspeth to enquire about the need for planning consent to upgrade the noticeboard.
5. Carolyn to source costs for capercaillie keepsakes.
6. Carolyn to edit the draft Carrbridge Capercaillie Newsletter in response to feedback from the group and liaise with Karen re sharing the newsletter online via Carrbridge News.
7. Elspeth to print copies of the newsletter for distribution in the village.
8. Charlie to build a box on the current Carrbridge Nature noticeboard to contain the newsletters.

The group agreed to meet again on Tuesday 4 October to review progress against the actions above and the Action Plan in general.
